The writing will be in a variety of forms.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> Learn a number of spellings each night from the P7 spelling scheme; these will be tested daily and in a weekly test.</p> <p><u>Reading</u> Shared Reading- Focus on Literacy book 5 will be used to develop comprehension skills. Independent Reading will be developed and encouraged through the mediums of novels and Ginn 360. Related written activities will be used to check knowledge and understanding</p>	<p><u>Grammar</u> Punctuation will be revised daily along with proverb, idioms, analogies, abbreviations, synonyms and compound words.</p> <p><u>Independent Writing</u> Pupils will complete a piece of independent writing weekly. The writing will be in a variety of forms.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> Learn a number of spellings each night from the P7 spelling scheme; these will be tested daily and in a weekly test.</p> <p><u>Reading</u> Focus on Literacy will continue to be developed along side poetry and dramatic text. Independent reading will continue through a range of novels and project style work.</p>	<p><u>Grammar</u> Children will be encouraged to make use of all aspects covered this year. They will develop proof reading skills in preparation for their new school. Work will also include rhyming words, diminutives, occupations, people, homes and alliteration</p> <p><u>Independent Writing</u> .Pupils will complete a piece of independent writing weekly. The writing will be in a variety of forms.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> Learn a number of spellings each night from the P7 spelling scheme. Testing will continue daily and on a Friday.</p> <p><u>Reading</u> Independent reading will now be well established and all children will have a fostered love of reading a wide range of texts. Books reviews will be presented to the class regularly.</p>
Maths	<p>Revision of all maths covered in P6 including fraction, decimals, percentages, algebra, handling data, 2D/3D shapes, coordinates, angles, scale drawing, negative numbers, volume, area, perimeter, time etc.....</p> <p>Mental strategies will be developed at the beginning of each lesson using a range of activities.</p>	<p><u>Geometry</u> Estimate the size of and angle and use a protractor to measure and draw angles of various sizes.</p> <p><u>Symmetry</u> One and Two axis of Symmetry. Rotational Symmetry. Congruence.</p> <p><u>Co-Ordinates</u> Plot points using co-ordinates, find the missing co-ordinate. Negative co-ordinates. Co-Ordinates of straight lines and curves.</p> <p><u>Develop Work on Roamer.</u></p>	<p><u>Algebra</u> The idea of equations and how to solve them.</p> <p><u>Statistics</u> To collect information and produce tables, bar charts, pie charts and pictographs. Interpret the data to find mean, medium, mode and range.</p> <p><u>Decision Trees</u> Sort and classify information. Answer a range of questions based on various decision trees. Collect data and design own decision trees.</p>
