We are delighted that your child will be making his/her First Holy Communion on the 12th September in Holy Trinity Church. I am sure that this will be an amazing day for everyone.

Unfortunately, the ceremony this year will be different from other years due to restrictions imposed due to the pandemic.

These changes will include:

- There will be three ceremonies
 - ✓ 10.00- previously P4AC. Now P5MML- Miss Mc Laughlin
 - ✓ 11.30- previously P4JW. Now P5HD- Miss Hughes
 - ✓ 1.00- previously P4CW and LSC2. Now P5MH- Mr Hackett and Mrs Sheehan/Mrs Mc Kinney

- Six family members are permitted to accompany the children to the service.
- We would ask adults to wear masks in the church and adhere to social distancing.
- Children will be seated at the front of the church and family members will be seated in the seats at the rear of the church.
- Parents are not permitted to take photographs during the service. There will be time between services to take photographs.
- As the church will need to be cleaned between each of the services we would ask parents to take photographs and leave the church 30 minutes before the next service is due to start.
- Children will receive communion on their tongue but adults will receive it in their hands.
- As multiple children will be unable to use the microphone, unfortunately children will not be doing Readings, Prayers of the Faithful or the Offertory this year.
- Music and singing will be provided by Miss Donnelly and Mrs Mc Kinney.
