Coronavirus

This is a very worrying time for everyone and I would like to reassure you that the safety of all of the children in Holy Trinity remains our main priority.

Can I ask you to send a message to the class teacher via SeeSaw or email Mrs Boyd on fionaboyd66@hotmail.com,

1. if your child or any members of your household have symptoms of Covid 19,
2. if your child or anyone in the household is waiting to be tested for Covid 19
3. If your child has been in contact with someone who has tested positive.
4. if your child has been told to self isolate by the PHA

Can I then ask you to please let us know the results of the tests when you receive them. We would ask you to do this before your child returns to school.

If you require any advice or guidance with regard to whether your child should attend school, please do not hesitate to contact Mrs Boyd.

Halloween Dress Up Day

Halloween Dress Up Day will take place on the 23rd October. Children may come into school in a Halloween costume or in their own clothes. We would ask for a contribution of £1.00 towards school funds. Children may bring in a Halloween party with them

School Bags

Following recent guidance from the PHA children are now permitted to bring school bags into school. They may bring their break. Lunch, water and homework folder in their school bags but may not bring pencil cases, toys etc. We would ask parents to spray schoolbags with a disinfectant spray each evening.

Covid 19

As we approach half term, I would like to take this opportunity to thank the parents, pupils and staff of Holy Trinity for their tremendous effort to ensure that everyone within our school community remains safe. With the rising cases of Coronavirus in the community, it was inevitable that some families would test positive. Like every other school, unfortunately we have had to close several bubbles over the past few weeks. Staff have been working very hard to send home work to children who are isolating. We have also been preparing materials and work for the children in the event of a “circuit break” lock down or in the event that a bubble has to isolate. Can I emphasise the importance of ensuring that you have signed up to SeeSaw and Microsoft Teams. Seesaw will be the main platform for providing you with information and it will also be the main means for you to keep in touch with the class teacher. All work will be sent home via SeeSaw or Teams so it is essential that you check **NOW**, before we have a lock down, that you can access these. Dropping off Zone

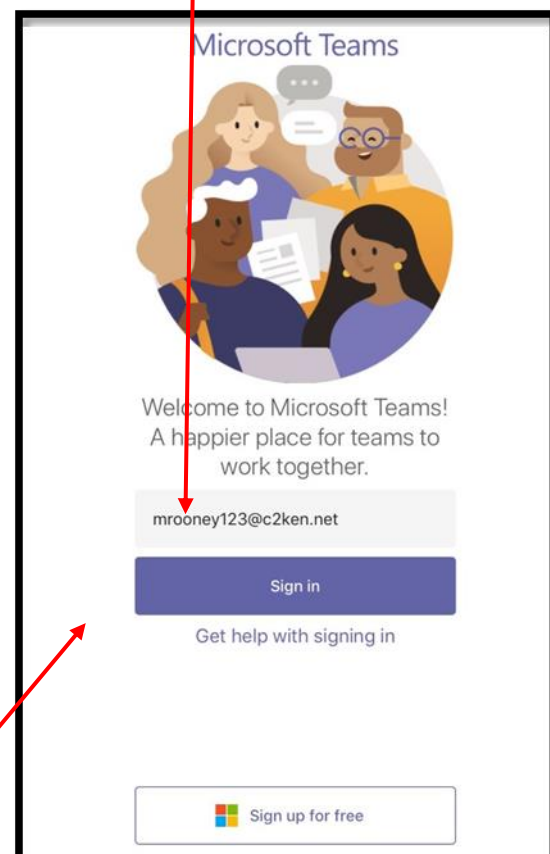
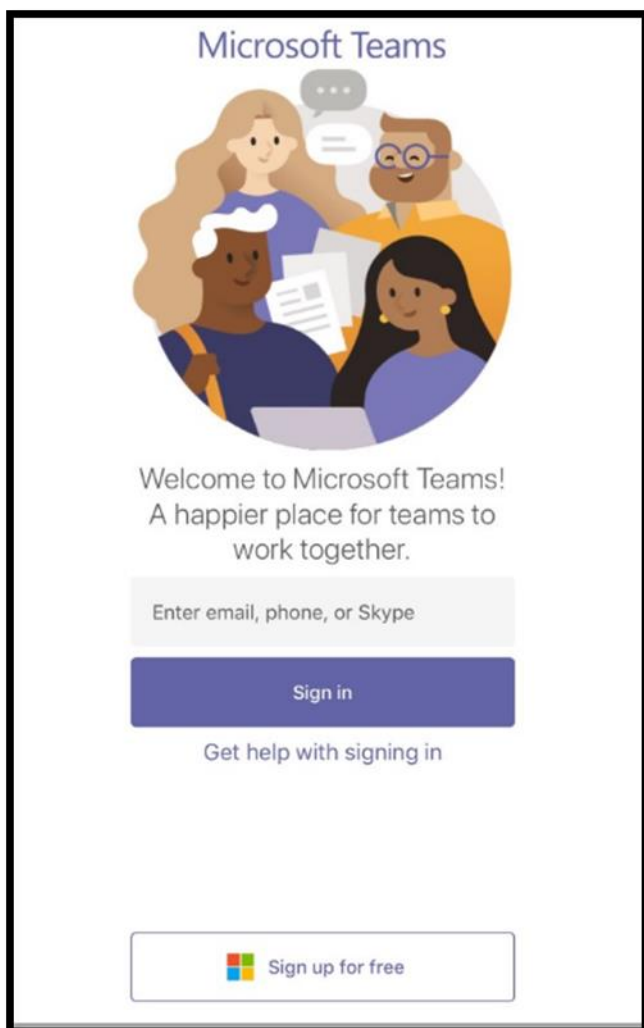
Download the 'Teams' app from the app store.

2. Type your sign in address.


This will be your child's C2k Username with **@c2ken.net** added at the end. Eg

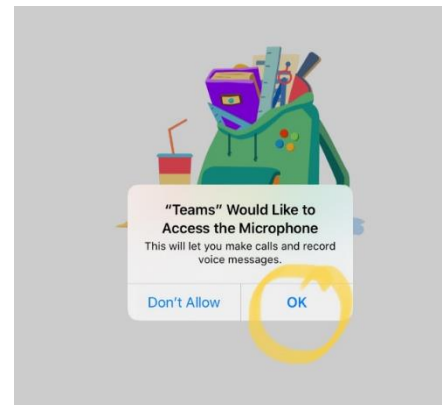
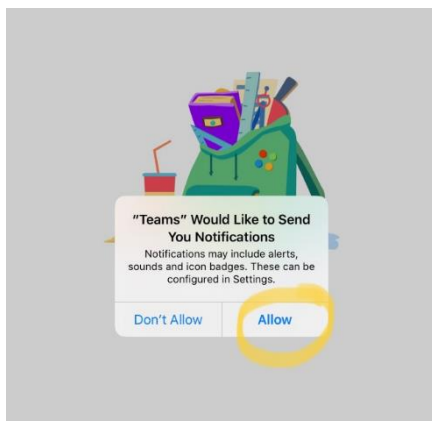

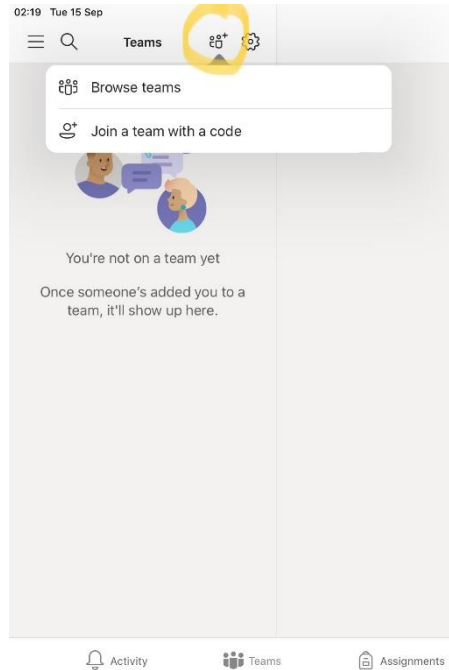
If you have more than one child using a shared mobile or device, you can add multiple accounts by going into the app settings. This can be found by tapping the 3 lines, top left corner of the app.

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Join a New Team on a tablet

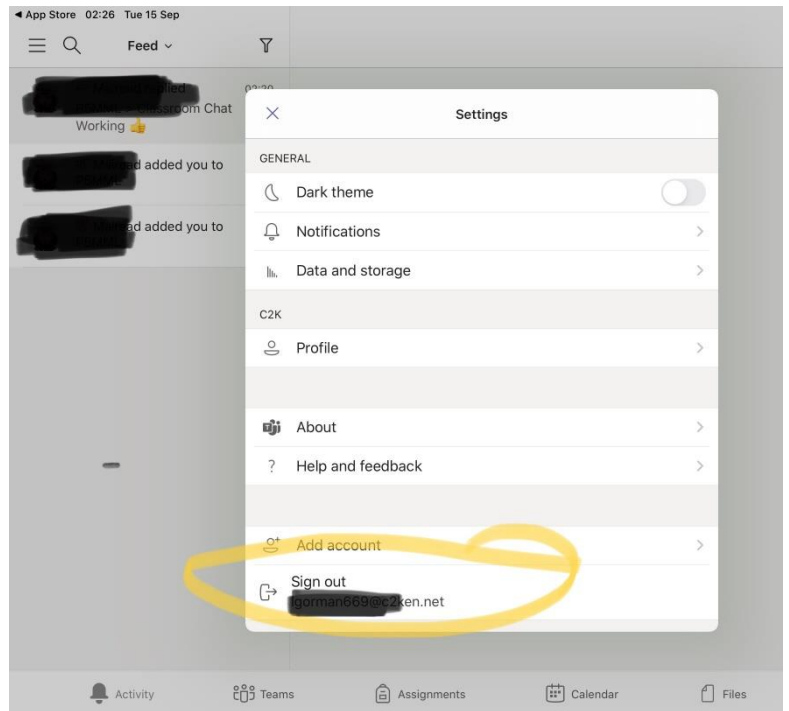
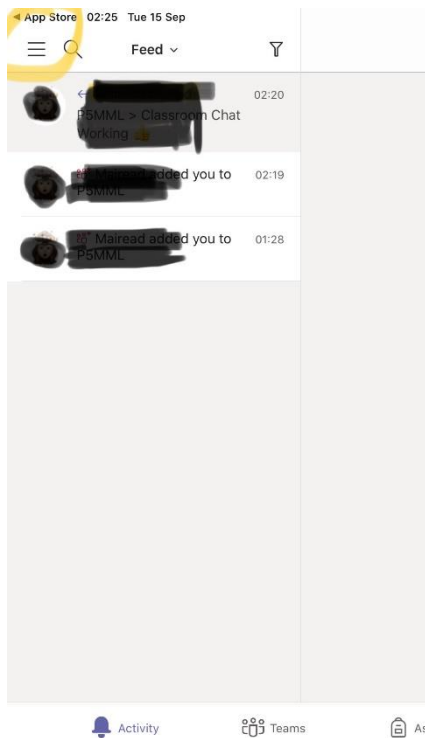


If you have more than one child using the same device:

Tap the 3 lines top left. Go to **Settings**. Then **Sign Out**.

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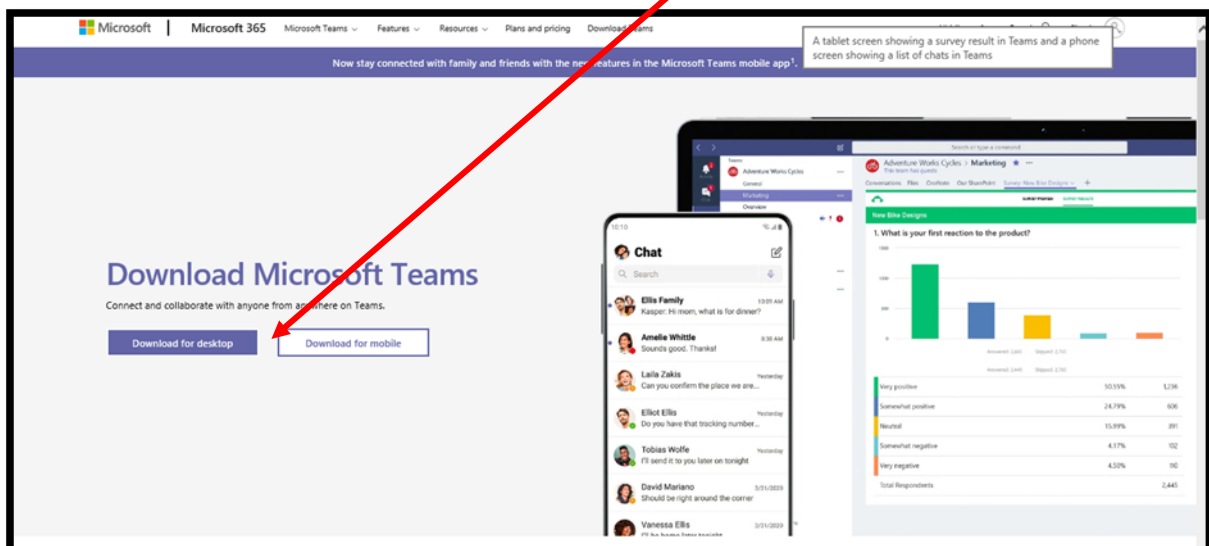
Signing into Microsoft Teams using a laptop or PC.

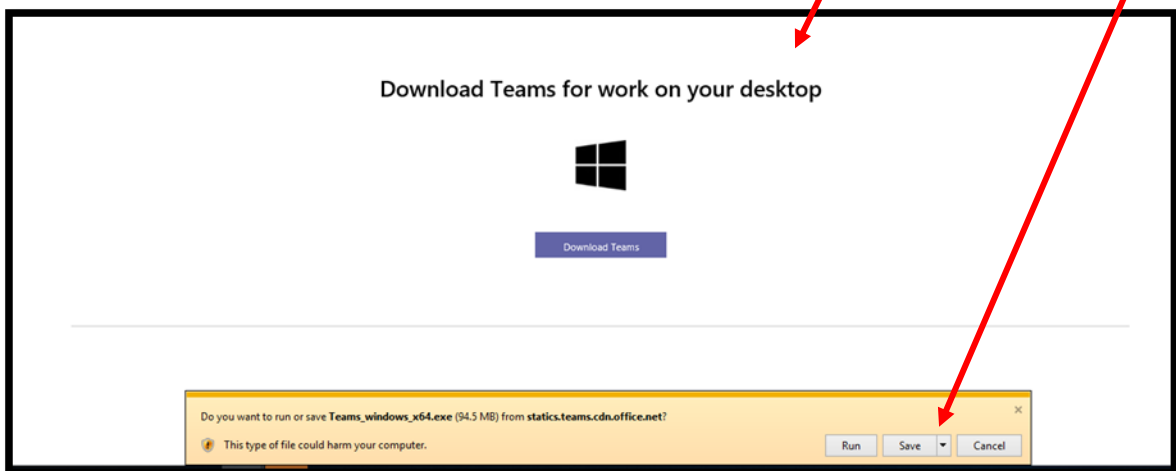
1. Select Download for Desktop.



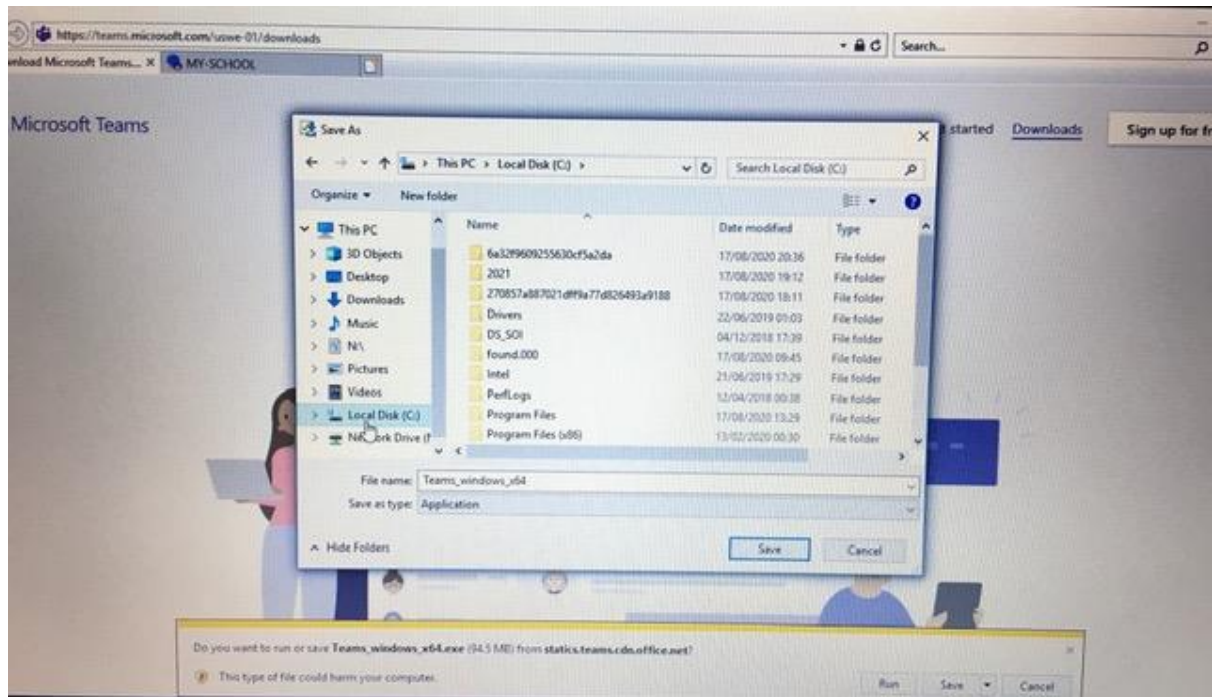
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2. Save it to your hard drive. Click Save and then Save and run.

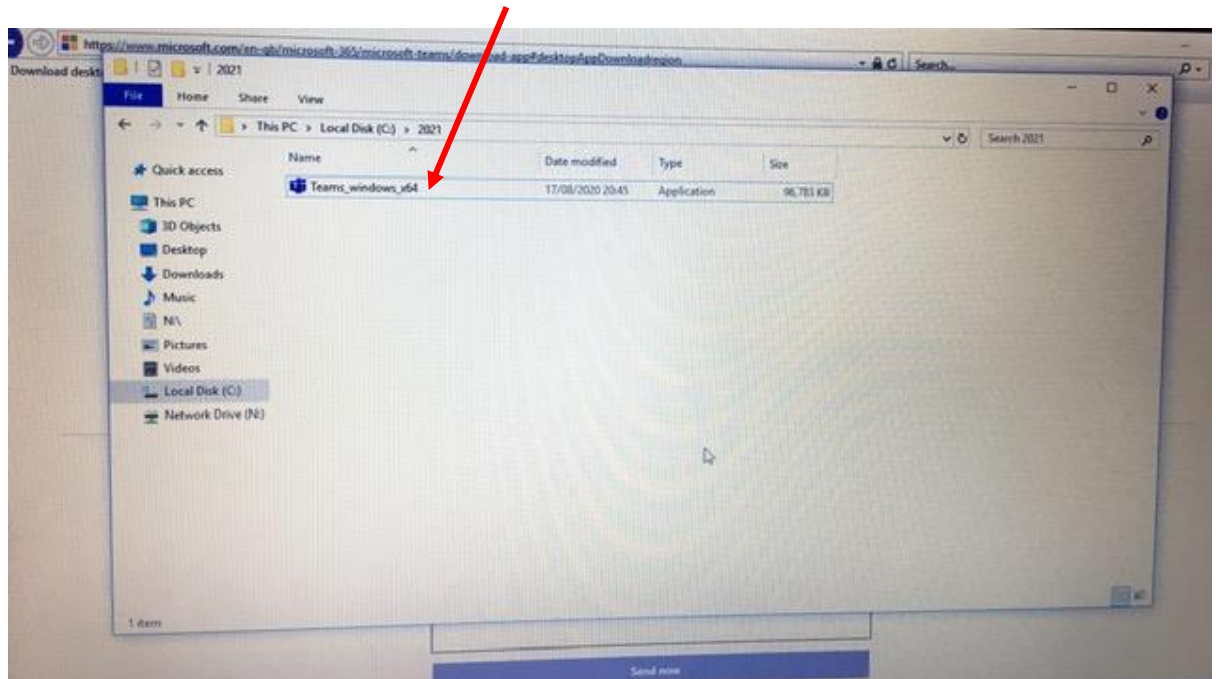
Decide where you want to save the file. Local disk C usually works well. Then click save.
