I would also like to thank our parents, who as well as family commitments and working from home, also took on the task of home schooling. Staff appreciated the support you gave to the children and the feedback, and photographs you shared with us. Thank you also for following the new rules and restrictions. Your support helped ensure that the number of positive cases in the school was kept to a minimum and the school community remained safe. I am sorry that you did not have the opportunity to attend Christmas concerts, Sports Day, Assembly etc but hopefully these can happen in the future.

The pupils this year have been amazing. It was difficult for them operating in bubbles, no PE lessons or singing, not being able to play with the children in other classes etc. In spite of the restrictions, and the support of staff they have had an excellent year. They have been happy, have worked hard and embraced the changes. They really are remarkable and you should be so proud of them, I know that I am.

I sincerely hope that you have a lovely summer and a well earned break. I believe that this difficult time has strengthened the Holy Trinity family and made us closer, stronger, more resilient and happier.
