**Easter Holidays** – Holy Trinity PS will close for the Easter break at 11:00 on Thursday 13th April and will reopen on 24th April.

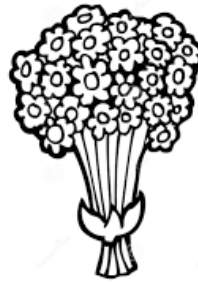
**TROCAIRE**
